

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# How the Postal Lending Library Works

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The postal library is free of charge. You can join by filling in the webform of the library page of our website [www.cerebra.org.uk](http://www.cerebra.org.uk) or by phoning our Freephone number 0800 32 81 159 and asking to speak to the librarian.

# Frequently Asked Questions

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## How do I join the library?

The lending library is a free of charge service. You can join by completing the webform on the Library page of our website [www.cerebra.org.uk](http://www.cerebra.org.uk) or phoning 0800 32 81 159 option 1, then option 2 and asking to speak to the librarian.

## How do you store my personal details?

We ask for your postal address, a contact phone number and email address, and your child's name, date of birth and condition in order to join you as a library member. We store your details securely on our internal database, which we never share with any third parties.

## Who can join the library?

Membership is open to the parents and carers of any child aged 16 or under with a neuro-developmental condition. We don't ask you to provide official confirmation of your child's condition in order to join the library. SENCOs at schools and nurseries and co-ordinators of family groups etc can also join the library.

## How do I borrow books?

To borrow a book either email [library@cerebra.org.uk](mailto:library@cerebra.org.uk) with your request or phone her on 0800 32 81 159 option 1, then option 2. You can borrow two books at a time for 28 days at a time.

We send the books out in the post with a freepost label for you to return them at the end of the loan period. Loan times can be extended as long as no-one else is waiting.

## How do I borrow toys?


